About the Authors

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Introduction

Time Management & Word Count

The instructions say, “*Write at least 250 words*”. Even though there is no IELTS restriction on the number of words you can write, writing 300 + words on Task 2 is really not necessary and is not effective time management. Nevertheless, there is no penalty for writing more than 250 words.

Answers under the word count are penalized in the Task Response criterion. When the examiner sees that your answer is short, they will count the number of words and impose a penalty.

Number of words	Task Response
240 +	No penalty
210 - 239	Minus 1 band
Under 210	Minus 2 bands

How Words are Counted

Numbers, dates and time are counted as words in the writing test.

- 30,000 = one words
- 55 = one word
- 9.30 am = one word
- 12.06.2022 = one word

Dates written as both words and numbers are counted separately.

- 12th July = one number and a word

Symbols with numbers are not counted.

- 55% = one word (the symbol “%” is not counted as a word).
- “55 percent” is counted as one word and one number.

Hyphenated words like “*up-to-date*” are counted as one word.

Compound nouns, written as one word, are counted as one word.

- *blackboard* = one word

If you copy sentences or parts of sentences from the task description, the words will be deducted from the word count.

Words and numbers in brackets are counted. This sentence has 9 words. The number in brackets is counted as a word.

- “*The majority of energy was generated by electricity (55%).*”

Test Tips – Time Management

- Don't spend longer than 40 minutes on Task 2.
- Time yourself when doing test practice tasks.
- Aim for 250-270 words.

Always plan your essay. This will have a positive effect on your time management.

Counting words can be time consuming. After each paragraph, quickly count the words and write the number on your answer sheet so you don't need to recount.

- The Computer Delivered IELTS test has an automatic word count onscreen.

Formal Vs Informal Language

IELTS Writing Task 2 is an academic essay and needs to be written in a formal style or tone. Some differences between formal and informal style.

Formal	Informal
Write words in full <i>I will, I am</i>	Use contractions <i>I'll, I'm</i>
Don't use idioms <i>All things considered...</i>	Use idioms At the end of the day...
No abbreviations, write words in full <i>The maximum amount...</i>	Use abbreviations <i>The max amount...</i>
Don't use imperative voice <i>Can you call me?</i>	Use imperative voice <i>Give me a call.</i>
Don't use colloquial expressions <i>He was dismissed.</i>	Use colloquial expressions <i>He got the sack.</i>

Grading

Task 2 is worth 67% of your overall writing band score, and answers are graded according to the IELTS Writing Public band descriptors.

You are graded in 4 criteria – Task Response, Coherence and Cohesion, Lexical Resource and Grammatical Range & Accuracy.

The criteria are equally weighted with 25% awarded for each category and the writing band score is the average of the four.

Task Response

Even though each criterion is equally weighted at 25% each, Task Response is the most important category as it is possible to get a lower band score than the other criteria if you do not answer the question.

The sub categories in Task Response are...

- Addressing the prompt
- Appropriate format
- Stating a clear position
- Extending and supporting your main ideas

Addressing the prompt

This means answering the question

Band 7: *The main parts of the prompts are appropriately addressed.*

Example: For both views & own opinion question, you have included a discussion of both views and stated your own opinion.

Appropriate format

Band 6: *Appropriate format used.*

Example: The essay DOES NOT include headings, sub-headings, numbered lists and/or bullet points. Task 2 is an academic essay and should be written only in paragraphs.

Stating a clear position

It's important that your opinion or "position" is clearly stated and your reasons to support it are consistently given throughout your answer. You also need to draw conclusions based on your position.

Band 7: *A clear and developed position is presented*

Example: For agree or disagree questions, the writer express a clear position ("totally agree") and the main ideas match this position.

Extending and supporting your main ideas

Band 7: *Main ideas are extended and supported*

Your main ideas will be stated in your body paragraphs. These ideas should be supported by "any relevant examples from your own knowledge or experience" as stated in the instructions.

Test Tips – Task Response

- ⇒ To address all parts of the task, analyze the question to understand the task requirements of the essay type.
- ⇒ Be familiar with the structure/format of all essay types.
- ⇒ Always plan your essay. This will help you answer all parts in a balanced and appropriate way.
- ⇒ Decide on your position/opinion and stick with it. Do not change your opinion half way through your answer.
- ⇒ When expanding on your reasons for your position in the body paragraphs, always include supporting details.
- ⇒ The task instruction already guides you on supporting details when they say include "any relevant examples from your own knowledge or experience"

Coherence and Cohesion

The Coherence and Cohesion criterion is almost the same for Writing Tasks 1 and 2. The only difference in Task 2 is the inclusion of *paragraphing*.

Coherence refers to the flow of your writing. Examiners are looking for how you have organized your answer into distinct paragraphs.

Cohesion refers to the use of cohesive devices or linking phrases and words that connect and show the relationship between parts of sentences and paragraphs.

A list of cohesive devices can be found on page 45

The sub categories in Coherence & Cohesion are...

- Organization of information and ideas. Clear progression
- Effective paragraphing
- Use of cohesive devices
- Referencing and substitution

Organization of ideas & effective paragraphing

Band 7: *Information and ideas are logically organized. Paragraphing is generally used effectively. Presents a clear, central topic within each paragraph.*

Task 2 is an academic essay and you are expected to have distinct paragraphs that include an introduction, body paragraphs and a conclusion.

Cohesive devices

Band 7: *A range of cohesive devices used... some inaccuracies.*

You can still achieve a band 7 even though you have made some mistakes in the choice of cohesive devices (linking words).

Referencing and substitution

Band 6: *Referencing and substitution may lack flexibility and clarity.*

Referencing is using pronouns (it, they, them, this, these... etc.) to avoid repeating what you mentioned earlier.

Substitution is using synonyms and paraphrase to avoid repeating what you mentioned earlier.

Test Tips – Coherence & Cohesion

- ⇒ Structure the Task 2 essay into clear paragraphs - introduction, body paragraphs and conclusion.
- ⇒ In the body paragraphs, avoid “listing” ideas - that is giving a list of ideas with little or no supporting details (explanation and examples).
- ⇒ Each body paragraph should have one central topic that is supported with your knowledge, experiences and examples.
- ⇒ Use a range of cohesive devices (linking words). Cohesive devices can also be used between sentences and are not restricted to the beginning of the sentence.

Example: **However**, the disadvantages should not be ignored.

The disadvantages **however**, should not be ignored.

- ⇒ Avoid repetition by using referencing and substitution.

Lexical Resource

This criterion grades your vocabulary resource (range) and how accurately you use it. The main requirements to achieve a band 7 are...

- **Sufficient resource:** Vocabulary used flexibly and accurately.
- **Idiomatic items:** The use of some less common idioms.
- **Style:** Task 2 is a formal report and you should not use informal language.
- **Collocation:** This is accurately using collocation.
- **Word choice, spelling and word formation:** You can still achieve a band 7 in spite of errors.

Grammatical Range and Accuracy

The Grammatical Range and Accuracy criterion measures your range of grammar (from simple to complex sentences) and accurate use. The main requirements to achieve a band 7 are...

- **Complex structures:** You should try to use more complex grammatical structures.
- **Errors in grammar and punctuation:** You can still achieve a Band 7 even though you make a few errors and these do not impede communication, and the majority of your sentences are error free.

Planning

Planning your Task 2 answer is essential for success. Don't be intimidated by the suggested time limit of 40 minutes. It's more than enough time to plan and write a high scoring answer.

Planning your answer will...

- Manage the time effectively
- Organize your ideas
- Keep you on topic
- Enable you to address all parts of the task

Try the following approach.

- Analyze the question and the instructions. Then write your introduction. Spend about 5 minutes on this.
- Next, plan the content of your body paragraphs. You can write your plan on the question paper or if you are taking the Computer Delivered test, most test centers provide paper and a pencil.
- When planning, write your ideas for the body paragraphs in prompt words.
- Select the ideas to include in your body paragraphs. One or two main ideas are enough. Do not list all your ideas. Spend about 5 minutes on this.
- After planning, write your body paragraphs. Spend about 20 minutes on this.
- Then write your conclusion. Spend about 5 minutes on this.
- Finally, reread your answer and correct any obvious vocabulary, grammar and punctuation mistakes. **DO NOT** attempt to rewrite sections. Spend about 5 minutes on this.

Introduction

An IELTS Writing Task 2 introduction should contain a **paraphrase** of the rubric (the task statement) and a **thesis statement**.

Avoid a general discussion of the topic or “academic hook”

Paraphrase:

Paraphrasing the task statement shows examiners that you understand the task and what you are required to write. Do not copy parts of the rubric as this will be deducted from your word count. Limit the paraphrase to 1 sentence.

Many people believe that the current system of both teachers and students in the classroom will no longer exist by the year 2050.

To what extent do you agree with this opinion?

Paraphrase of the statement

It is claimed by a majority that the contemporary practice of students interacting with teachers in actual classrooms is forecast to disappear by 2050.

You can paraphrase by using...

Synonyms: Words and phrases that have similar meaning.

Example: Statement: believed - Paraphrase: claimed

Changing the form of the word:

Example: from verb to noun: believe - belief (*Many hold the belief that...*)

Using different grammatical structures.

Example: Statement: Many people believe - Paraphrase: *It is claimed by a majority*

Thesis Statement

After paraphrasing the statement, write the thesis statement which has 2 parts. These parts can be in any order.

1. A statement of intent or purpose - what you will do in your essay.
2. State your position/opinion in response to the instructions.

Example: To what extent do you agree with this opinion?

I strongly disagree with this statement, and this essay will detail the reasons why.

Pronouns: It is acceptable to use pronouns in your thesis statement.

Example: *I strongly disagree with this statement and I will detail the reasons why in my essay.*

Stating a clear position is a main requirement of the Task Response criterion.

Band 7: *presents a clear position throughout the response.*

State your position clearly in the introduction and be consistent in following it all the way through your essay.

Body Paragraphs

In planning stage 2, you have already listed the ideas in support of your position. Now you should select which ideas you want to include in your answer.

When selecting, choose the ideas that you can easily provide supporting details for. Which ideas can you give clear and relevant reasons and examples for?

Avoid “listing”. This is where you choose too many ideas to include in your body paragraphs. One and a maximum of two ideas are enough as each one needs to have supporting details. One main idea per paragraph should be enough if it is properly supported.

Topic Sentence

Start the body paragraph with a **topic sentence** that summarizes what you will write in the paragraph. A topic sentence is an introduction to the content of your paragraph.

Example: *I believe that remote learning is not an effective approach when it comes to teaching children and adolescents.*

Supporting Details

After the topic sentence, you should provide relevant supporting details using your knowledge, experience and give examples.

Example: *This is because these groups of pupils lack the concentration levels for distance learning where it is necessary to sit in front of a screen for long periods, usually at home where there are too many distractions.*

Giving Examples

Examples don't need to be 100% true or accurate. They can come from many sources such as articles, documentaries, official research, personal experience, etc.

You can introduce examples with phrases such as, “*According to government research...*” or “*For instance, my experience of remote learning was...*”

When giving examples, you can back them up with statistics and, again, these don't need to be 100% genuine.

Example: *For instance, in my country in 2018, political leaders implemented a pilot scheme of studying remotely with several secondary schools. The result was that 80% of pupils had worse academic results when compared to other institutions that did not employ such a system.*

Conclusion

A clear and relevant conclusion is as important as all the other elements of your answer. According to the Task Response criterion, unclear conclusions will be graded at band 6.

What to include?

A conclusion is a summary of the content of your essay. It should show the examiner that you are bringing everything to a close.

Always begin with a simple... “To conclude,” or “In conclusion,”. IELTS Writing Task 2 is a formal, academic essay so avoid colloquial expressions such as...

“In a nutshell,” or “When all's said and done,”

- Restate your position (for opinion questions) from the introduction. Don't copy your position word for word. Use synonyms and paraphrase.
- Restate the main reasons for your position from the body paragraphs. Don't include the supporting details. Don't copy your main reasons word for word. Use synonyms and paraphrase.
- Conclusions should be limited to one or two sentences.

What NOT to include?

- Never include any new information in the conclusion. A conclusion is a summary of what you have already written. Ideas with supporting details should be in the body paragraphs.
- Avoid generalizations and keep it relevant and specific to your answer.

Unit 1: Opinion Essays

Test Tips – Opinion Essays

- ⇒ There are three types of opinion essays.
- ⇒ **Do you agree or disagree? - To what extent do you agree with the statement?**
These are exactly the same questions and can be answered in the same way.
- ⇒ **Do the advantages outweigh the disadvantages?**
- ⇒ **Is this a positive or negative development?**
- ⇒ Opinion essays require you to state your opinion or position in response to the statement.
- ⇒ The structure and content of the essay will depend on the position/opinion you take.
- ⇒ Once you have decided on your position, stay with it and don't change your mind half way through your answer. You don't have time to rewrite and restructure your essay.

Essay Structure

Note: These essay structures apply to the “agree or disagree”, “positive or negative” and “Do the advantages outweigh the disadvantages?” essays.

Essay Structure: 100% (One side)

Paragraph 1: Introduction

Paraphrase the statement. Include your thesis statement.

Paragraph 2: One side

1, maximum 2 reasons (ideas) why you believe in one side - with supporting details.

Paragraph 3: One side

1, maximum 2 more reasons (ideas) why you believe in one side - with supporting details.

Paragraph 4: Conclusion

Restate (paraphrase) your position and main reasons for one side from the body paragraphs. No new information.

Essay Structure: 50-50 (both sides are equally valid)**Paragraph 1: Introduction**

Paraphrase the statement. Include your thesis statement.

Paragraph 2: One side

1, maximum 2 reasons why you believe in one side - with supporting details.

Paragraph 3: The other side

1, maximum 2 reasons why you believe in the other side - with supporting details.

Paragraph 4: Conclusion

Restate (paraphrase) your position and main reasons for both sides from the body paragraphs. No new information.

Analyze the Task

Introduction: Thesis Statement

Test Tips – Thesis Statement

- ⇒ The thesis statement has 2 parts. These can be in any order.
 1. A statement of intent or purpose - what you will do in your essay.
 2. State your position/opinion in response the instructions.
- ⇒ For opinion questions, there are 2 possible positions you can take.
 1. 100% one side OR the other
 2. 50-50 both sides are equally valid
- ⇒ Taking the position of “mostly”, “partially”, “somewhat” is not particularly clear and you will need to give more reasons for one side than the other. Your answer will be unbalanced. Therefore, it is not recommended to take this position.

Band 7 Task Response: *a clear and developed position is presented.*

ELTS Writing Task 2 is a formal academic essay and the language used to state your position/opinion should be in formal style.

Plan the Body Paragraphs

Test Tips – Planning Body Paragraphs

- ⇒ After you have written the introduction, plan your body paragraphs. Take 5 minutes for this.
- ⇒ Don't try to brainstorm as many ideas as possible.
- ⇒ Limit your ideas to 2 or 3 main ones.
- ⇒ Write your ideas for the body paragraphs in prompt words, not full sentences.
- ⇒ Select a maximum of 2 main ideas that you can expand on with supporting details.

- ⇒ After you have planned the content of the body paragraphs, you should write them in 20 minutes.
- ⇒ Choose the ideas from your plan that you can easily provide supporting details for.
- ⇒ Start the body paragraph with a topic sentence that summarizes what you will write in the paragraph.
- ⇒ All ideas should be supported with your knowledge, experience and relevant examples.
- ⇒ Avoid "listing". This is where you choose too many ideas to include in your body paragraphs. One and a maximum of two ideas is enough.

Test Tips – Concession

⇒ When the writer chooses '**one side**', she can use concession where she acknowledges an opposite opinion before she states the main idea that remote learning is not suitable for youngsters.

Example: *While it is true that remote learning has become an increasingly popular and convenient method of learning especially for adults and college students, I believe that this approach is not effective when it comes to children and adolescents.*

⇒ Using concession is a very useful strategy to use in the topic sentence and you don't need to back it up with supporting details.

⇒ This is an example of a more complex sentence that will score higher in Grammatical Range and Accuracy and Coherence and Cohesion criteria.

Expressions for Concession

Admittedly + (opposite opinion); **nevertheless**, I am convinced that (your opinion)

I accept that + (opposite opinion); **in spite of this**, I believe that (your opinion)

Although it may seem + (opposite opinion); **however**, I would argue that (your opinion)

Conclusion

Exercise 8: Read the conclusion and delete the inappropriate and irrelevant information.

To conclude, in my opinion, I believe a balance of meat and vegetables in one's diet is the healthiest option. that would have the advantage of safeguarding people's jobs. According to the Department of Health' research in 2024, this has been proven to be the most suitable choice. However, consumption of meat ought to be reduced for health and environmental reasons, and alternatives should be considered. For example, meat substitute produced in a laboratory is an option.

Unit 2: Discuss Both Views and Give Your Own Opinion

Test Tips – Task Requirements

- ⇒ This essay combines discussion with opinion.
- ⇒ This is one of the more challenging essays since you are asked to write more than the other question types.

Band 7 Task Response: *The main parts of the prompt are appropriately addressed.*

- ⇒ This means you have discussed both views and stated your own opinion all with supporting details.

Band 5 Task Response: *The main parts of the prompt are incompletely addressed.*

- ⇒ This can mean you may have discussed both points of view but have not given your own opinion with supporting details.
- ⇒ Your own opinion can agree with one of the points of view but you should give a different reason/idea.
- ⇒ It is not advisable to agree with both points of view because it will require two different reasons/ideas why and will take longer to write.
- ⇒ You can give a different view that does not agree with the other points of view, with supporting details.
